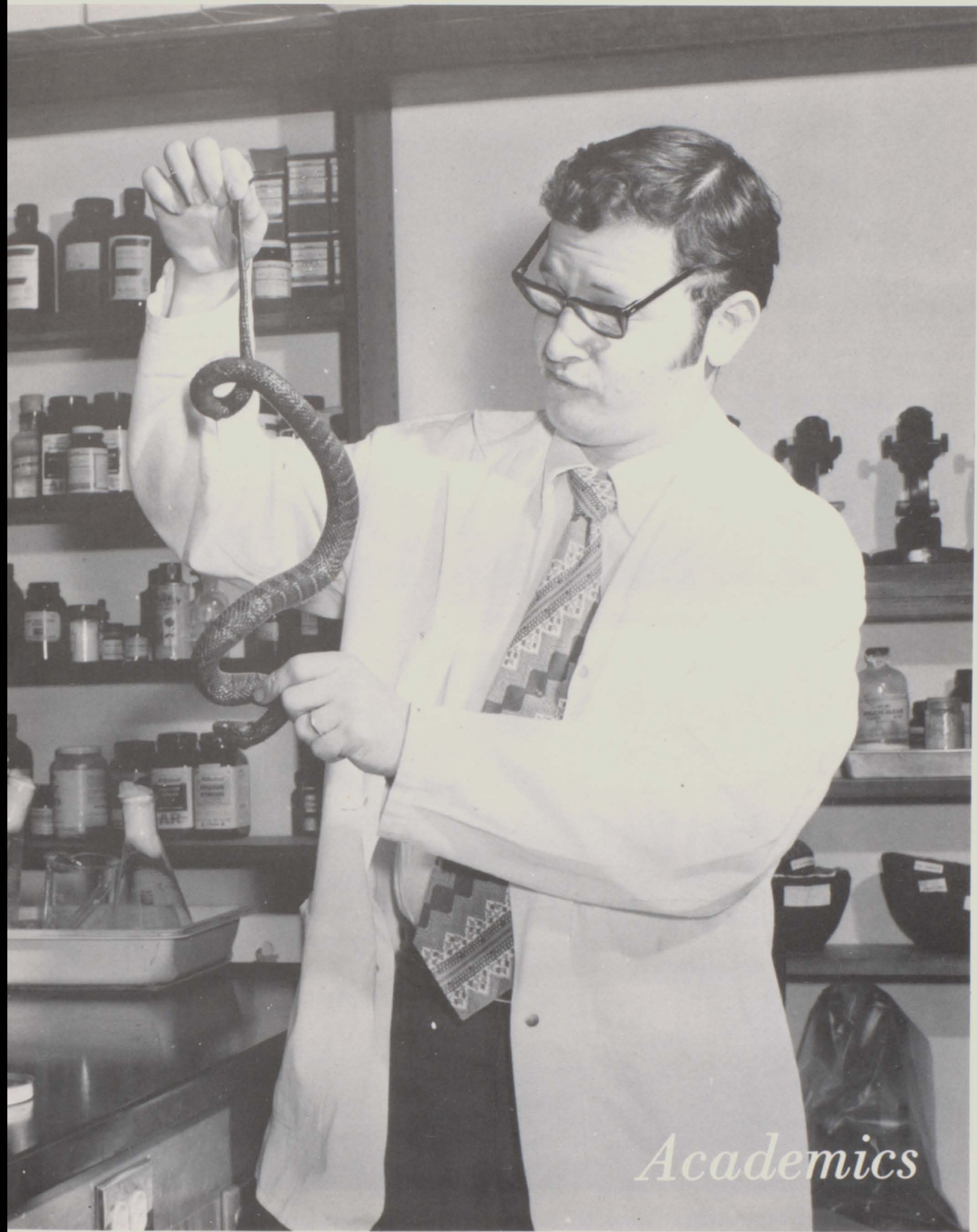


Just Because . . .
