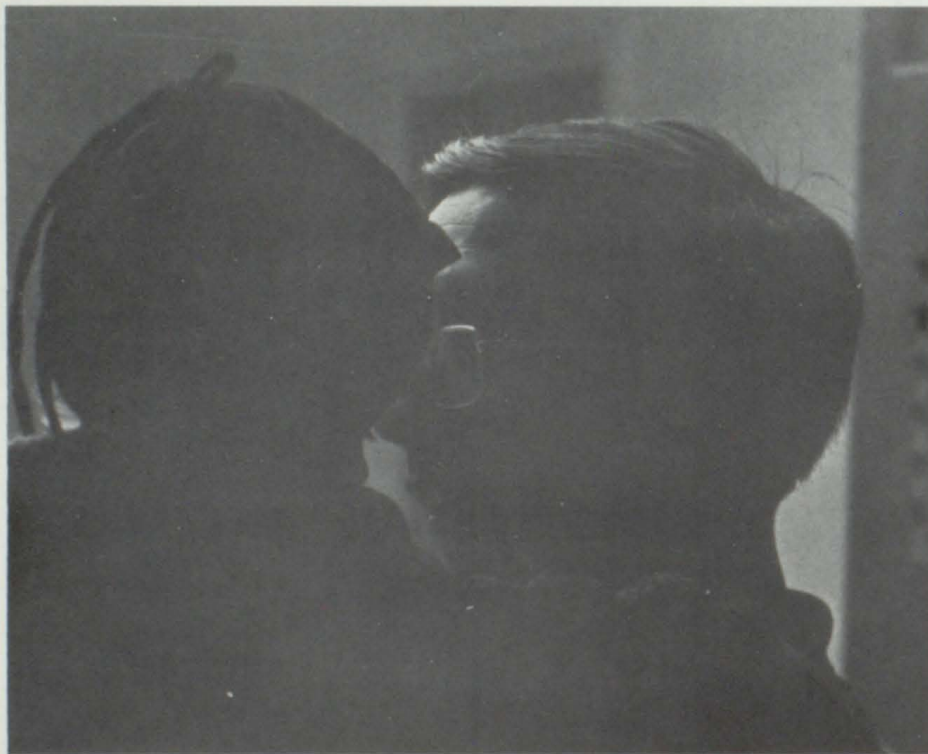
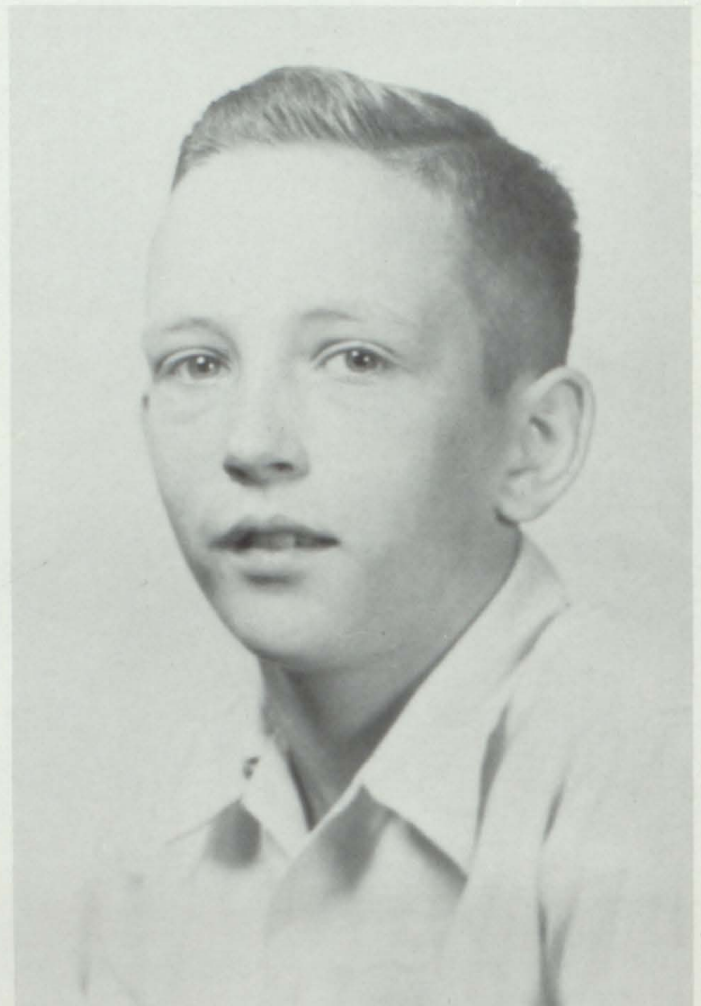




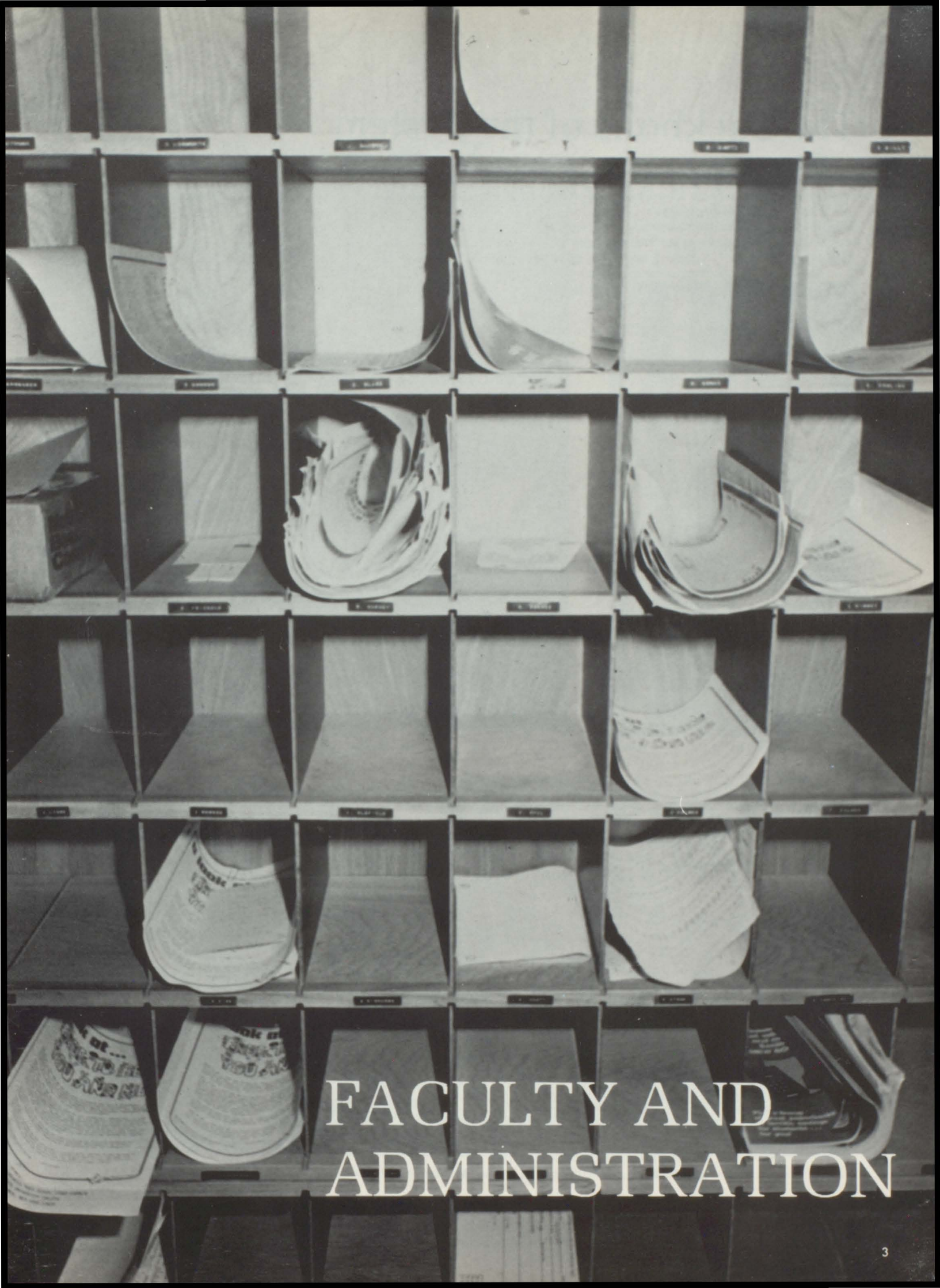
# A Momento of Thanks
