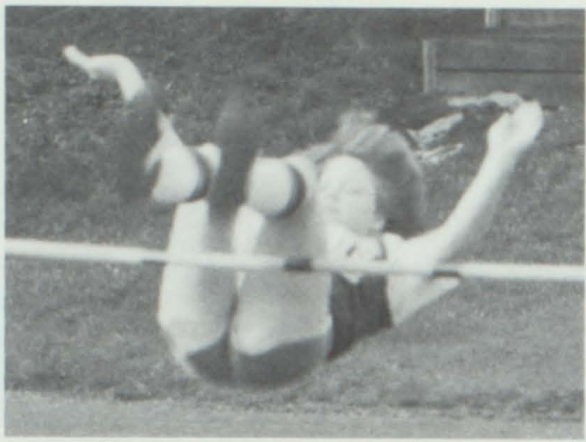


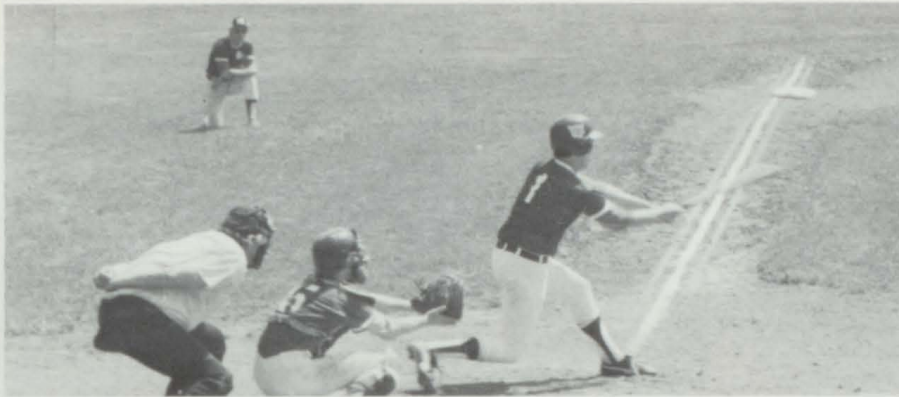
“Leaving is the Beginning”

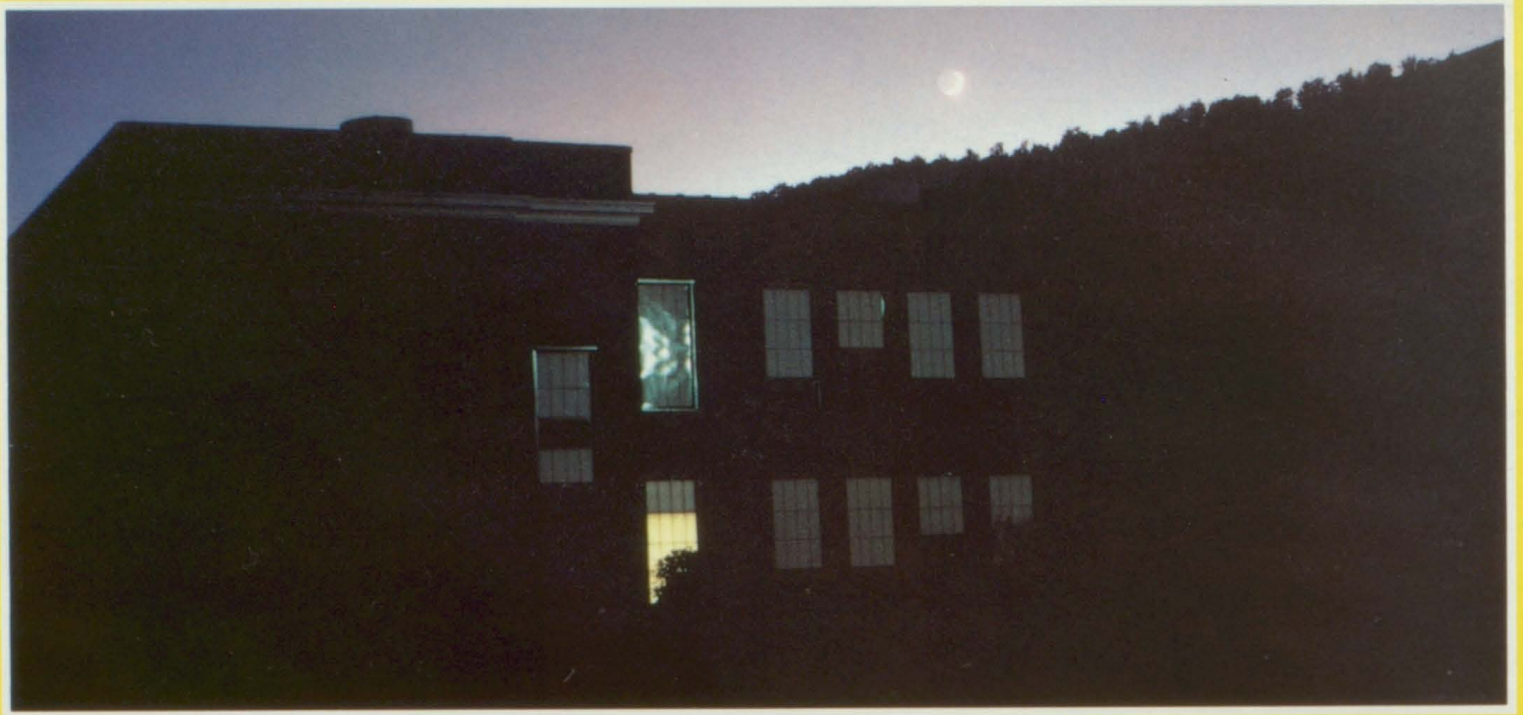


To each season there is a sport and as one begins, blossoms, and ends, so goes the other. In the fall, while the weather is clear and crisp, the sports are staged outdoors.

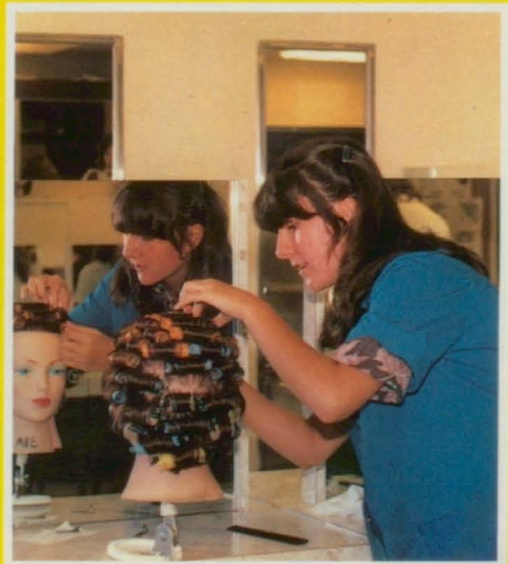
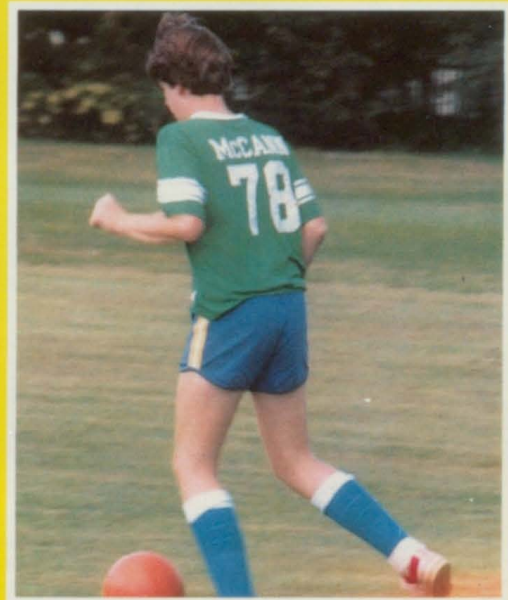
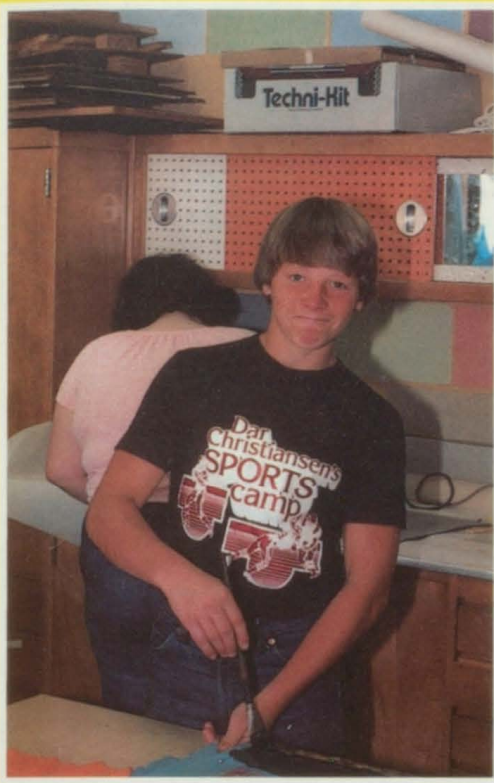
As fall moves on and colder weather forecasts winter, the sport scene moves on indoors to the hardboards and the mats.

#### B-G is Number 1

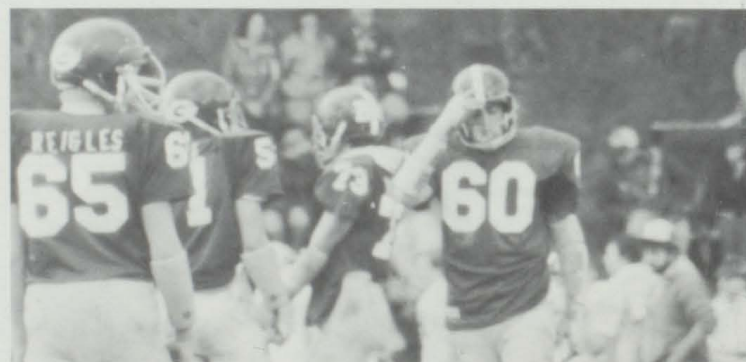
For the first time in fourteen years the B-G Bobcat football team finished number 1 in their league. The 1980 edition finished with a 6-1 league mark, 7-2 over all. It was the first football championship for Bainbridge-Guilford Central School since 1967 in the old Pioneer League.

The championship was the first for three year head coach Steve Rice, and for seniors Paul and Larry Laing, Chris Oliver, Jim Carroll, Gregg Thornton, Dennis Rowe, and John Williams.

Although probably the smallest team in the league in terms of physical size, this year's Bobcat team was characterized by exceptional quickness and aggressiveness. The championship was especially satisfying to a team that before the season people had written off as being too small.

The biggest wins for this year's team were an 8-6 win over then-unbeaten Oxford, a 21-0 win over then-unbeaten Harpursville, and a 15-12 win over Unatego that served the championship. The win over Oxford broke the Blackhawks' 13 game unbeaten streak, the third longest in the state at that time.

The Echo staff congratulates this year's number one team for their fine accomplishment.

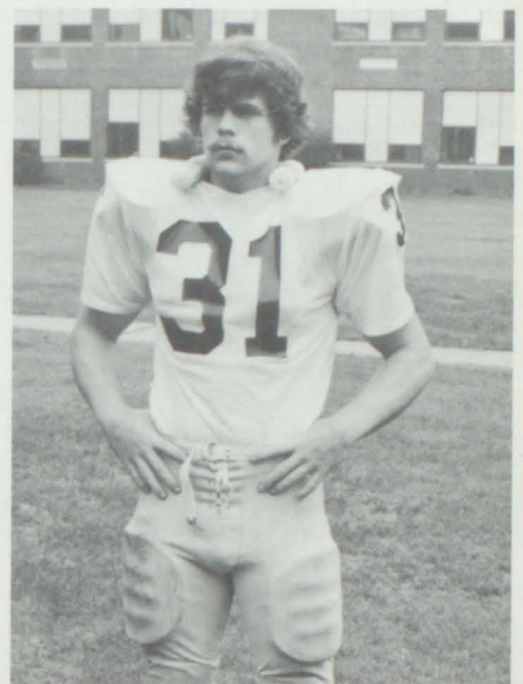
