A strange new foreign language has even been created, and it seems to be expanding every day.

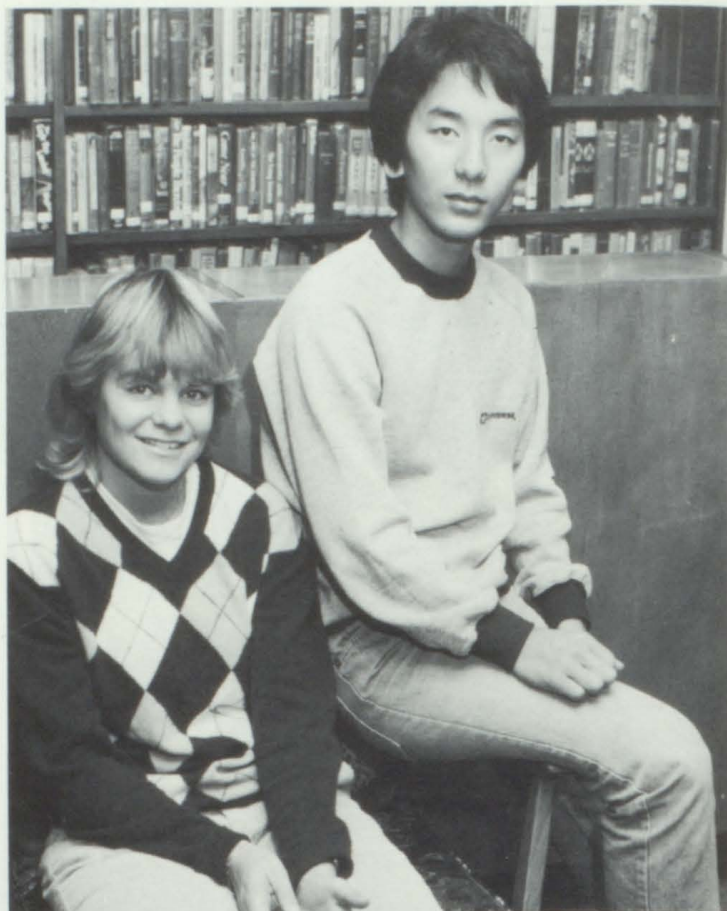


OUR FOREIGN FRIENDS

It is located on the west coast of Kyushu Island, 500 miles south of Tokyo. While Naoto does see some snow in his hometown, it only comes once or twice a year and even then they only get a trace.

In Japan, high school is not required, but 99% of the students enroll anyway. One reason for this is that it's very hard to get into a college. Only the most educated students are accepted. Another difference Naoto has noticed is that in his own school, there are many after-school activities. There are at least 50 clubs of which Naoto is a member of three. He is on a rowing team, in a photography club, and an English speaking society.

The one thing Naoto misses the most about Japan is his English class! He says the reason he misses it is because it was "very easy!"
