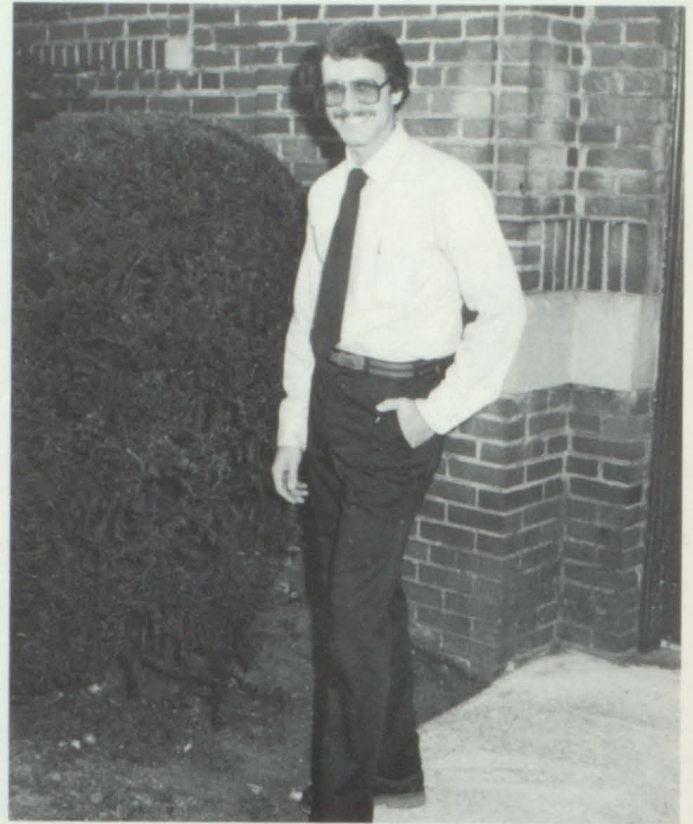
"Discovery"

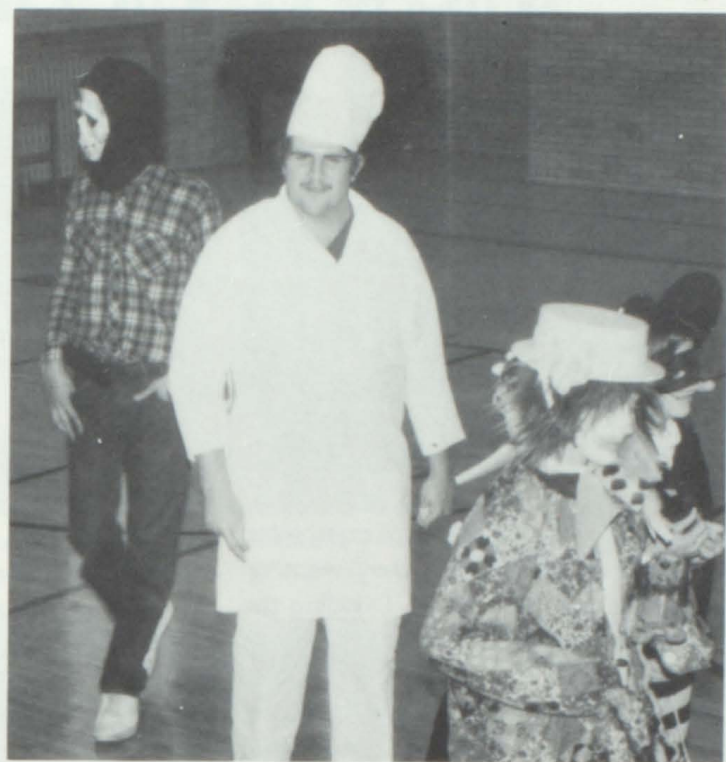


MR. T SAYS "BE THERE!"

of 36-square meters. Some examples of what was done in the field were learning the slope in the plotted area, took temperatures of soil at specific depths, temperature of the air, at specific heights and temperatures of the water, and the speed of water. They also determined the direction of the wind.

The students had a "hands-on" approach in this field trip. This experience helped enhance their understanding of this material that they had learned about in the "inside classroom" discussion.



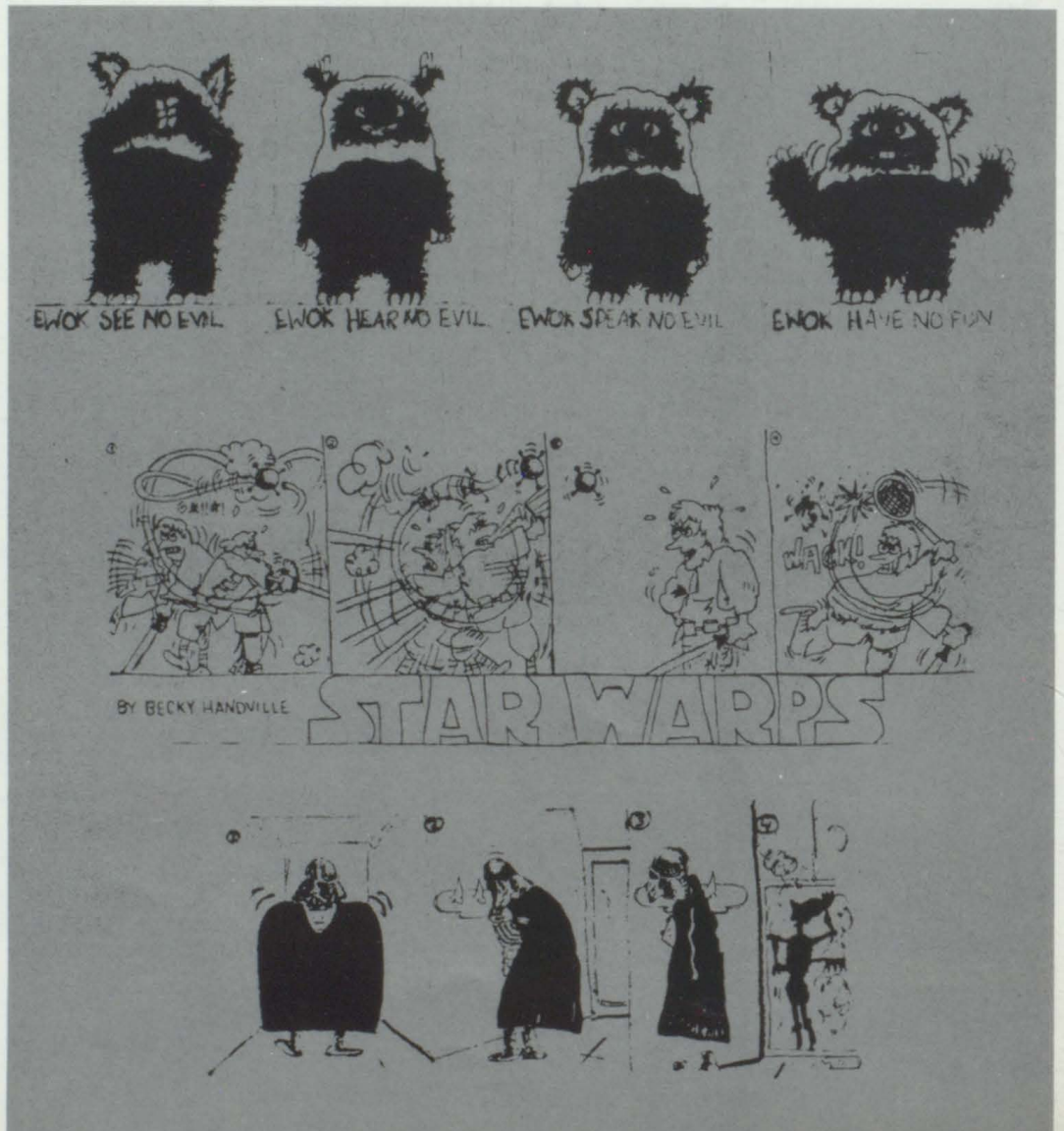
BECKY HANDVILLE — CARTOONIST

After she graduates in '85, Becky plans to attend a 4-year college to pursue a film and dramatic arts career.



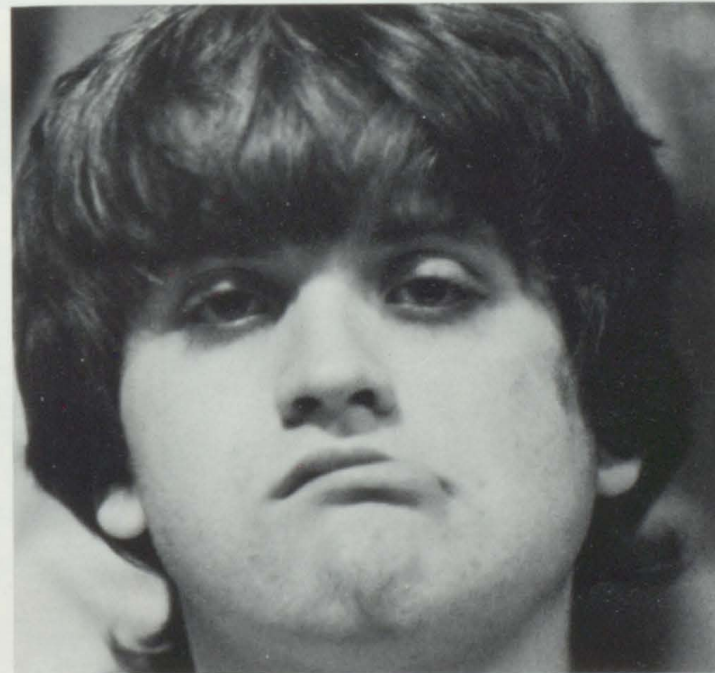
