Challenger: A Memorial

The Space Age officially began twenty-nine years ago when the Soviets launched Sputnik. Since then, NASA has made terrific gains including the 1961 launching of Freedom 7, carrying Alan Shepard in America's first manned space launch. Despite the tragedy of Apollo 7 in 1967 when three men were killed we continued to pursue our goal of landing man on the moon before 1970. This vision was realized in July, 1969, when the Eagle touched down on the moon with Edwin Aldrin, Neil Armstrong, and Michael Collins on board.

Since that flight, NASA has blasted forward, especially with the shuttle program. Twenty-four successful shuttle voyages have been witnessed by America's children, romantics and stargazers. Unfortunately, this flawless record was marred when the January 28th launch ended in tragedy.

The five men and two women who died in the Challenger explosion are seen as heroes, leaders of our generation. Along with the six astronauts, on board was the first "civilian," teacher Christa McAuliffe. They took the risk but as astronaut Ronald McNair once said, "You can only become a winner if you are willing to walk over the edge." We will remember the services of these people for many years and in many ways, as explorers, history makers, and the teacher who wasn't afraid to try.


The face of anguish
