Born in the Bronx, Mr. Carroll attended school there until his freshman year, when his family moved to Milford, NY. There, he played high school basketball, football, and was the team's pitcher for baseball. Also, he played semi-pro baseball with the Milford Macs ball club.

In 1952 he enlisted in the U.S. Army, serving until 1954, stationed in Anchorage, Alaska as an anti-aircraft gunner. After that, he attended Hartwick College in Oneonta, majoring in sociology with a minor in English.

Upon graduation, Mr. Carroll taught for five years as a junior high school English teacher. He also has coached basketball and baseball at the Junior Varsity level, and basketball at the Varsity level as well.

Mr. Carroll also earned three Colgate degrees in three and a half years, obtaining his permanent certification, a Master's degree in English, and a certificate in Administration.


During his years at Bainbridge-Guilford Mr. Colf was Department Head for several years. He was also student funds advisor during his early years here.























B-G BLUES, Summer 1988
