

Congratulations Coach McNaught: 2016 Coach of the Year

The 2016-2017 BGAH Bears season was another record breaking season. Again this year, every event the team entered finished first or second in team competitions minus a 12th place finish at the UE Duals. So for two years running the Bears have been 1st or 2nd except the UE event. The dual meet record was 16-4 with losses to larch schools, Hilton, Brockport and the largest school in NYS, Brentwood. Loss #4 was at the hands of #1 ranked small school for the second year in a row, Mattituck. Highlighting the dual season was downing Norwich 37-36 at Norwich, missing two starters and also winning the schools' first ever Section IV Dual Title. Good luck to our graduating seniors, Austin Carr, Madison Hoover, Mitchell Weist, and Nick Decker. Their contributions will be missed.

What year did you start working at B-G? 1975. I have had various jobs here including payroll clerk, records management officer coach, nurse assistant, and attendance officer.


