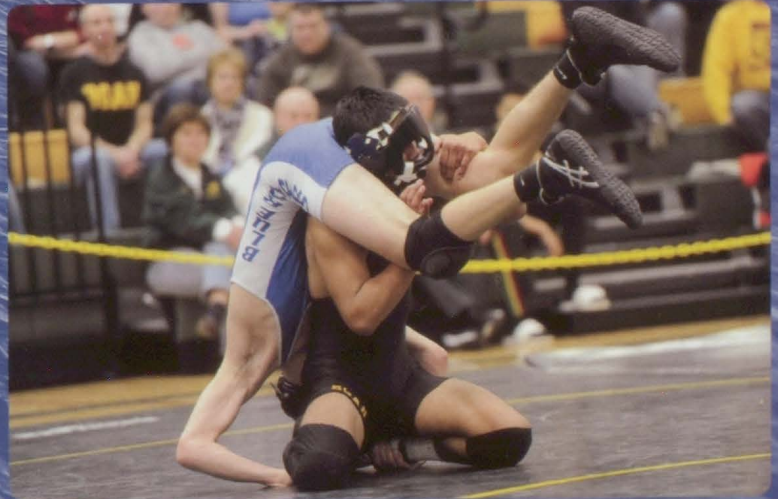
Congratulations Coach McNaught: 2016 Coach of the Year

The 2016-2017 BGAH Bears season was another record breaking season. Again this year, every event the team entered finished first or second in team competitions minus a 12th place finish at the UE Duals. So for two years running the Bears have been 1st or 2nd except the UE event. The dual meet record was 16-4 with losses to Iarch schools, Hilton, Brockport and the largest school in NYS, Brentwood. Loss #4 was at the hands of #1 ranked small school for the second year in a row, Mattituck. Highlighting the dual season was downing Norwich 37-36 at Norwich, missing two starters and also winning the schools' first ever Section IV Dual Title. Junior Ben Bivar also placed 5th in NYS DII. 8th grader Brody Oleksak snagged a wildcard to participate at the states and went 1-2. Good luck to our graduating seniors, Austin Carr, Madison Hoover, Mitchell Weist, and Nick Decker. Their contributions will be missed.
