

B-G School Board Information

- Candidates must be 18 years old, qualified voters in the school district, residents of the district continuously for one year.
- Cannot be employed by the board or live in the same household with a family member of the same school board.
- Receive no remuneration, except for the satisfaction that comes from rendering an indispensable public service.
- Elected for a 3-year term – terms are staggered so all board positions are never open at the same time. Election is the third Tuesday in May.
- Meetings are twice monthly usually the first and third Thursdays of the month. Annual meeting is the first meeting in July.
- Board Packets containing information on most agenda items are mailed the Friday before the meeting. Board members are expected to review this information before the meeting.
- May have a committee assignment.
