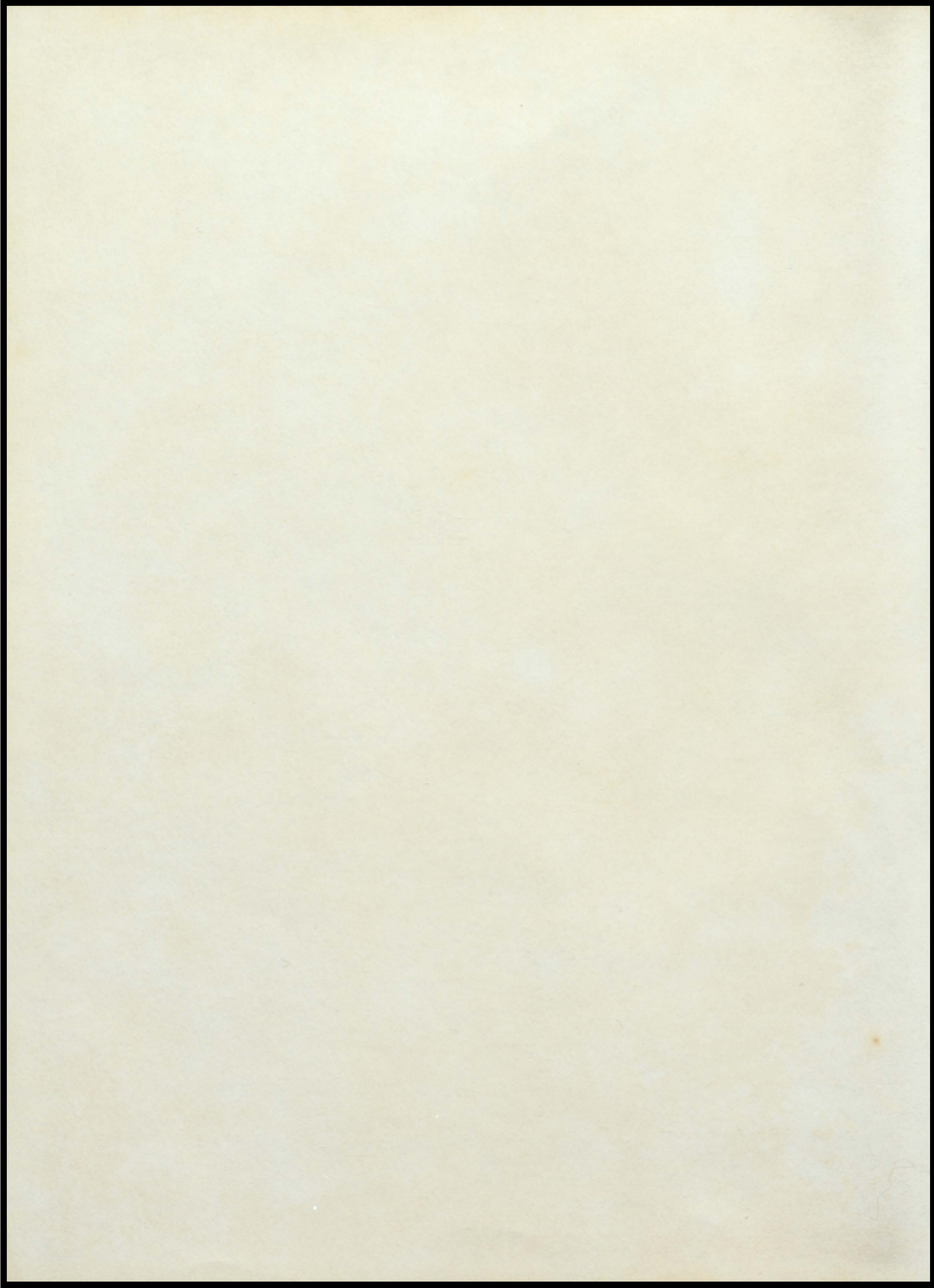

"My congratulations and best wishes to each of you!"

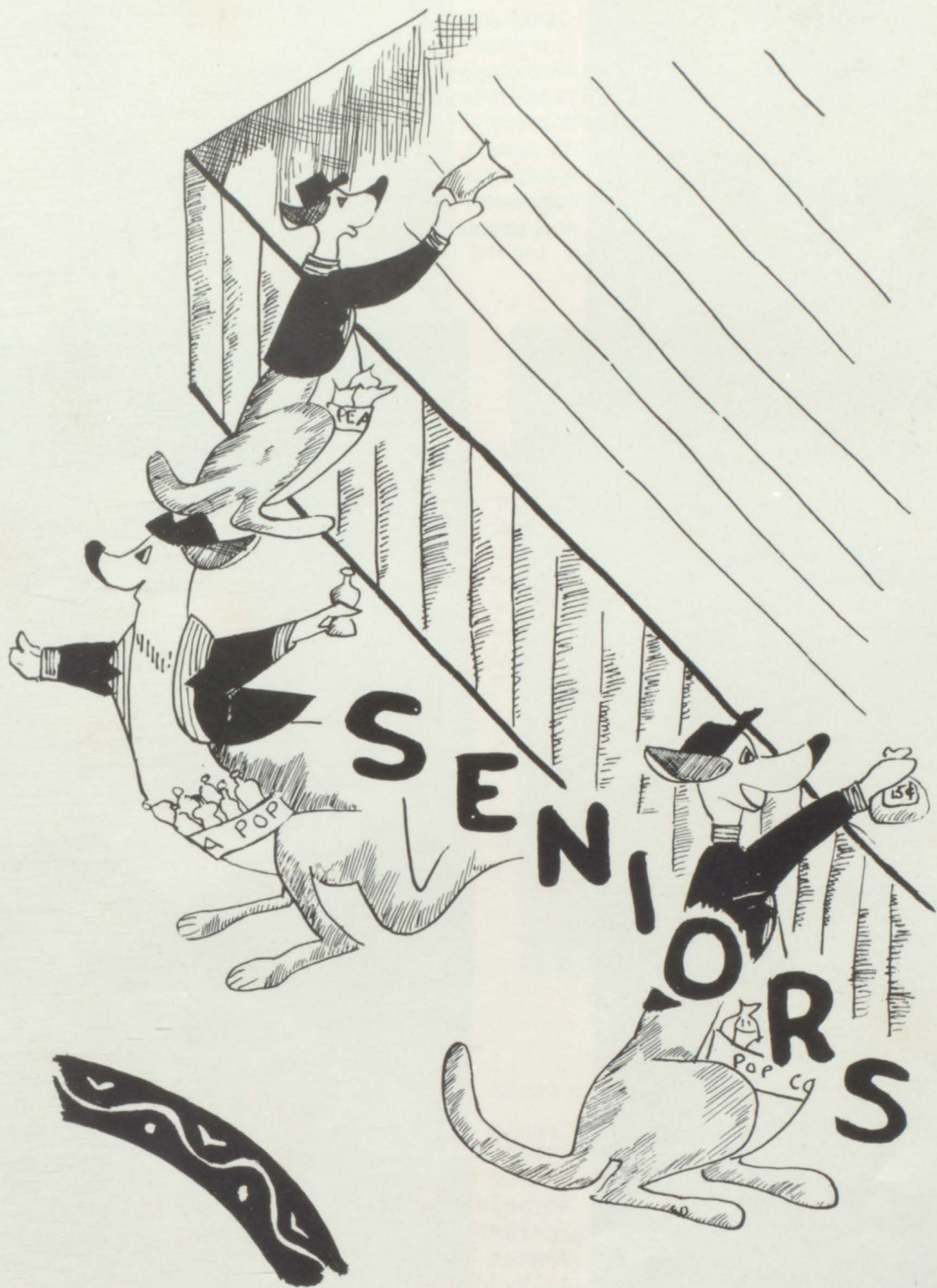

Judy Casey wills her good looks and neat appearance to Judy Norris. We hope that you, Judy, will set a shining example for your classmates as our Judy did for us.

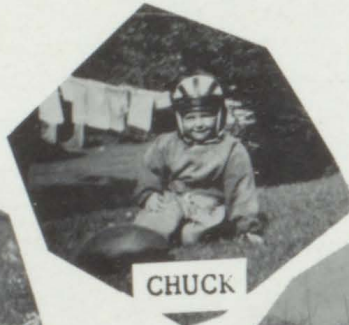
Gilbert Norris leaves his extensive fund of information to Danny Casey and David Randall. We are sure there will be an ample supply for both.
