

## RESOLUTION REGARDING STATE ENVIRONMENTAL QUALITY REVIEW

**WHEREAS**, the Board of Education of the Bainbridge-Guilford Central School District (the “Board”) has considered the effect upon the environment of the proposed District-wide 2022 Capital Project work, which will include, but is not limited to the following:

**Jr. / Sr. High School** – Building and site upgrades and renovations, including educational program, infrastructure, mechanical, electrical and plumbing upgrades. Site improvements include parking lot pavement reconstruction and drainage improvements at the soccer field.

**Greenlawn Elementary School** – Building and site upgrades and improvements to the educational program, infrastructure, mechanical improvements and fuel tank replacement. Site improvements include parking lot pavement and sidewalk reconstruction. Reconstruction of six tennis courts, track reconstruction, new synthetic turf and new 100 car stadium parking lot with drainage improvements.

**Guilford Elementary** – Building and site upgrades and renovations, improvements to the educational program, infrastructure, mechanical and plumbing improvements including fuel tank replacement. Site work includes drainage improvements at the back of the school and along School Street, as well as sidewalk and curb improvements.

**Bus Garage** - Building and site upgrades and renovations, roofing replacement, and mechanical and plumbing improvements. Site improvements include asphalt drive and parking reconstruction, drainage improvements, and chain link fence replacement.

**WHEREAS**, the Board has reviewed the scope of the project and has further received and considered the advice of its architects with respect to the potential for environmental impacts resulting from the proposed action; and

**WHEREAS**, the Board has reviewed the Proposed Action with respect to the Type II criteria set forth in 6 NYCRR Part 617.5(c), now therefore;

**BE IT RESOLVED**, by the Board of Education as follows:

1. The Proposed Action does not exceed thresholds established under 6 NYCRR Part 617, the State Environmental Quality Review Act, (SEQRA).
2. The Board hereby determines the Proposed Action as a Type II action in accordance with the SEQRA regulations.
3. No further review of the Proposed Action is required under SEQRA.
4. This resolution shall be effective immediately.
