- ◆ Conducts seminars for employees on a variety of topics including balancing work and family, child care issues, and parenting concerns

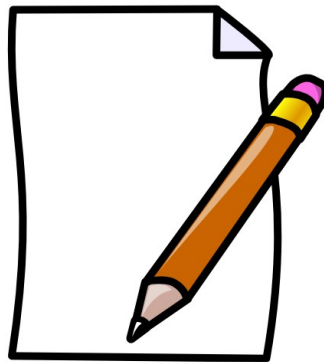


Questions To Ask When Inquiring About A Summer Program

- ◆ Is your program registered with the Office of Children and Family Services (OCFS) as a School-Age Child Care program, certified with Department of Health for a summer camp or does it have another oversight agency?
- ◆ What will you be expected to provide?
 - Snacks/meals ?
 - Bug repellent?
 - Sun screen?
 - Floaties and a towel?
- ◆ Is transportation provided?
- ◆ What are the times and additional costs of before and after camp care?
- ◆ Do field trips and special event opportunities require additional fees?
- ◆ Do they have emergency procedures in place? What are they?
- ◆ What is the “drop-in” policy for parents?
- ◆ How can parents get involved?

Additional Reminders:

- ◆ Where swimming is offered, make sure to:
 - ◆ Review your child’s skill level with the instructor.
 - ◆ Ask to see the instructor’s certification.
- ◆ Ask the camp to describe typical activities planned for your child’s age group.

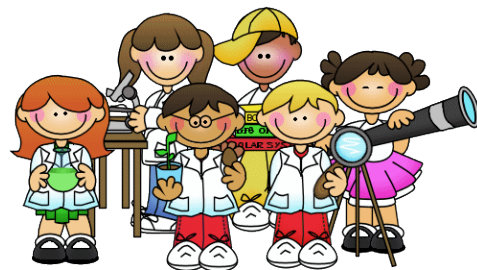

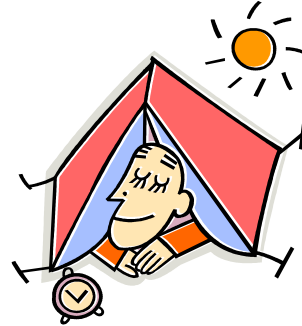
